Abstract:

The past few months have illustrated the extent to which scientists and scientific institutions are exposed to federal policy making. Conversely, scientists are often not accustomed to thinking about how they can interact with public policy. To support this thinking, I provide an overview of federal actions impacting science over the past few months and highlight opportunities for scientist interaction with public policy.
